Frequently Asked Questions:

- Do participants need a liability insurance form?
 - All participants are the responsibility of their parish's insurance.
- Do priests need to sign off on registration forms?
 - Not this year.
- Do we need to have all information already complete for our dance routine (music, region, village) when we register?
 - If you already have it finalized, please include it. If you need to make changes, you can do so by sending them by Jan 31 to Anna Yortzidis at anna.yortzidis@gmail.com.
- How does an individual (not a dancer or singer) get registered with a parish?
 - Register a group, then click add members - here you can add the type of member (advisor, priest, etc.)
- Will the birthdays of advisors added to a group be factored into the age breakdown?
 - No. While, birthday is asked for everyone (advisors etc.), only those marked as dancer or choir will be factored into the age breakdown.
- Itemized pricing
 - Available as a print out under the metropolis website as FEES & SCHEDULE

- Costumes
 - Judging of costumes is separate from dance judging - you will be given comments to give you productive feedback, but this will not be included in scoring.
 - Ethnic presentation and presentation not costume
 - Wearing a costume correctly (ex. How headscarves are tied)
 - Costumes receive a separate award
 - Please send up the costume(s) you want to be judged (however many). Also, a director can go up with the kid(s).
- Competition - how many groups per church?
 - You don't need 5 groups! - The groups are based on the average age of the group. If you have mostly young GOYAns, then your group will compete against others with a similar average age.
 - What are the categories?

- Exhibition - for 5-6 year old average
 - Primary
 - Junior
 - Intermediate
 - Senior
 - Advanced
- How do you pay?
 - Payment by card or check
- Are children size T-shirts available?
 - We will have that added to registration.
- Can you please clarify the one email address per registration?
 - Each group (dance or choir) needs to have one email address to which we will send a confirmation email. You cannot then use that same email address to register another group or another individual.
- Is there prop set up time?
 - 5-10 minutes between performances, so 5-10 minutes to set up
- How does the timing by the judges work for short songs?
 - If less than a minute, it's not scored.
- Can 5 and 6 year olds participate?
 - If average age is 7 and under, they will be exhibition. But if the director wants them to compete, they can. They will still pay full price.
 - In notes under the second round, please mark exhibition if your group is age 7 and under if you are not competing.
- Are human props allowed?
 - If they aren't dancing, they do not need to register. But if they're dancing they are a dancer and are calculated into the average age.
- Please register your priest with your group.
- Can we get more clarity on what will happen on Friday?
 - Agenda details will be available at our last meeting leading up to MDF.
- Where do we send research for dance?
 - Please send to Anna Yortzidis at anna.yortzidis@gmail.com.
- Does a church have to have a Dance group or can they send only a Choir?
 - You do not need both. We are happy to have your community's youth participating in MDF 2026 in either or both categories!
- Everyone must register in advance for the Awards banquet as we will have a seating chart.
 - We'll work to seat everyone together
 - Please also register in advance for the Glendi.
- Will the Choir be provided a keyboard?
 - No. Please bring your own keyboard if you are using one for accompaniment.
- Does the Choral award during dancing need to be for a certain length to qualify?
 - No.
- Do you need to send costume photos in advance?
 - If possible, yes please.

- Also include who made them and share where the pattern is from etc.
- What workshops will be available this year?
 - Workshops will be announced soon.
- Liturgy will be assigned seating - attendance is mandatory
- Can GOYAnS serve as Altar servers during liturgy?
 - Yes! If your GOYAn would like to serve, please email Fr Symeon at frsymeon@nj.goarch.org so he can coordinate.
- Do parents have to attend with their children?
 - No. But each parish needs to have an advisor to child ratio that will allow them to supervise all youth in their care.
- ALL Advisors and directors must be fully compliant with youth safety.

Questions outstanding

- Can we edit our registration ourselves?
 - We will ask Cvent.
 - You can register additional dancers later, but you'll need to tell us who to add if editing capabilities isn't possible.
- Will you provide props of tables and chairs?
 - We will ask the hotel if they can provide 2 rectangular tables (dining room size) and 8-12 tables.
- How many microphones will there be available for dance for instruments/singing?
 - We will work to have 2 or 3 available.
- What are the stage dimensions of the stage?
 - Stage dimensions for older and younger groups are the same as last year.
 - We can get dimensions next week.
 - We will confirm different flooring from last year.
- What is the schedule for workshops and practice rooms?
 - This schedule will go out once all competition schedules have been set. It will be emailed and posted to the website.
